

Biography

Ljiljana Maksimovic was born in 1956 in Novi Pazar. She finished elementary school and high school in Raska as the holder of the Vuk's diploma. She enrolled at the Faculty of Economics in Kragujevac in 1975 and graduated in 1979 with an average score of 9.56. She completed her master's degree in 1981 and defended the master thesis “Objectively determined estimates in the function of optimal use of resources” in 1988. She defended the doctoral dissertation “The forms of property, directions and possibilities of transformation of a social enterprise” in 1997 at the Faculty of Economics in Kragujevac.

In the period 1980-1985 she worked in the firm as a financial planner and analyst and since 1985 she has been employed at the Faculty of Economics in Kragujevac, where she was in 1998 elected as assistant professor. In 2004 she was appointed associate professor and in 2013 was elected as a full professor.

She was the editor of the journal “Economic Horizons”, a member of the program committee of numerous scientific conferences, the editor of several collections of papers. She has published over 90 scientific papers (articles, monograph, textbook).

The main areas of scientific interest are microeconomic theory, transition, privatization, globalization, competitiveness, oligopolies, cartels, competition policy.

During her career, she attended several universities abroad (Economics University in Bratislava, Economic Academy in Krakow, University of Information Technology and Management in Rzeszow, Faculty of Economics, Udine).
