After completing bachelor studies, she enrolled in postgraduate studies at the Department of monetary, banking and financial management of the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade in academic year 1996/97. She passed all exams included in the curriculum with grade point average 9.87. She defended her master thesis entitled "Theoretical and methodological problems of testing the financial performance of banks" on 13 February 2003, based on a unanimous decision of the Expert committee.
