

Vladimir Obradović, PhD, Associate Professor

He was born on 8 September 1978 in Užice. He completed primary school with honors and as a holder of a diploma "Vuk Karadžić. He completed the high school of economics in Kosjerić with honors and as a holder of a diploma "Vuk Karadžić.

He enrolled in the Faculty of Economics of the University of Kragujevac in the school year of 1997/98. In the third year of the study, he opted for the course of Economic Statistics and Informatics. During the study, he achieved an average grade of 9.27. He defended his graduate work in the subject of Theory and Analysis of Balance Sheet on 9 September 2002 with a grade of 10. He was one of the recipients of the scholarship provided by the Government of the Kingdom of Norway for the year of 2001.

In the school year of 2002/03, he enrolled in postgraduate studies at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Belgrade, in the course of Financial-Accounting Analysis. During the study, he achieved an average grade of 9.44 and defended his master's thesis entitled "Financial Segment Reporting" on 19 July 2007, thereby achieving a master degree in economics.

He defended his PhD thesis, entitled "Globalization of Financial Reporting Standards" on 3 February 2012 at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Kragujevac, thereby achieving a doctoral degree in economics.

He was employed at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Kragujevac on 10 March 2003, as an assistant-beginner for the subject of Theory and Analysis of Balance Sheet. In June 2008, he was elected to the position of assistant in the subjects of Financial Reporting and Theory and Analysis of Balance Sheet. In January 2013, he was elected to the position of assistant professor in the same subjects. In June 2017, he was elected to the position of associate professor in the subject of Financial Reporting. In addition to teaching the subject for which he was elected, he works as a teacher in the subjects of Special-purpose Balance Sheets, on master studies, and International Financial Reporting, on PhD studies. From April 2006 to March 2013, he was the secretary of the Department for Accounting, Auditing, and Business Finance, to which he belongs.

From 2012 to 2017 he was engaged in the Project of the Faculty of Economics of the University of Kragujevac: "From Crisis to Economic Development: Contemporary Challenges in Economics and Management". From 2018 he has been engaged in the Project of the Faculty of Economics of the University of Kragujevac: "Economic Aspects of European Integration – Experiences and Perspectives of the Republic of Serbia". He

participated in the TEMPUS project: "Master program in Educational Leadership", the holder of which was the Faculty of Education of the University of Kragujevac, based in Jagodina. In school 2016/17 and school 2017/18 year, in order to realize the mentioned TEMPUS project, he has been engaged in the teaching of Finance, Law and Administration in Education at the the master study program Leadership in Education, which is being realized at the Faculty of Education of the University of Kragujevac, based in Jagodina.

He is the author of a number of scientific papers, primarily in the field of accounting, auditing, and business finance. His scientific interests are predominantly related to international aspects and standards of financial reporting, as well as to the analysis of financial statements. He is a member of the Economists Society of Kragujevac.
